

RULES OF THE ROAD USING VEHICLE RENTALS

Driver Responsibilities & Agreement

I agree that I will:

1. NOT OVERLOAD THE VEHICLE WITH CARGO OR PEOPLE.
2. Perform a walk around safety and damage Inspection when picking up and dropping off the van.
3. Adjust side and rear-view mirrors before departing.
4. Not permit anyone not authorized by the rental agreement to operate the vehicle.
5. Ensure that passengers wear seatbelts while van is in operation and remind them prior to departure.
6. Keep doors locked while van is in operation or is left unattended.
7. Not use a cell phone. I will pull over to a safe location. Have a co-pilot.
8. Not smoke nor allow any passenger to smoke inside the van.
9. Be aware of all overhead obstructions (e.g. drive-thru, parking garages).
10. Not operate a vehicle under the influence of alcohol or drugs, to include prescriptions and over the counter medicines that may cause drowsiness.
11. Be aware of all dashboard lights. Do not operate a vehicle if brake warning lights are on, or if the brakes are not operating properly.
12. Observe all traffic laws, ordinances and regulations and use safe defensive driving practices.
13. Not transport unauthorized passengers such as hitchhikers.
14. Drive the vehicle at speeds appropriate for road and weather conditions.
15. Be responsible for all tickets.

In Case of Breakdown or Accident (Think "PASSENGER SAFETY FIRST")

1. Pull as far off the road as possible.
2. Understand the breakdown procedures outlined by the rental company.
3. **In case of an accident, CHECK ALL PASSENGERS FOR INJURIES** If someone is injured call 911 immediately.
4. Do not argue, accuse, blame, make any admissions or apologize for the accident.
5. Always call the appropriate law enforcement agency (highway patrol, police, sheriff, etc.) and report the accident. This can be done through 911.
6. Remain calm and use your best judgment.
